**Freedom of Information Reference: FOI-2024-000278 – Immunoglobulin Drugs.**

I refer to your freedom of information request that we received on 23rd July 2024 requesting the following information.

We have now completed the search of our records and can provide you with the following information:

Please see attached Appendix 1 – Immunoglobulin Vials issued to Scottish Hospitals, for the breakdown by product of immunoglobulin distributed to NHS Scotland Hospitals in each month for April, May and June 2024.

Under Section 17 of the Freedom of Information Scotland Act, 2002 (FOISA) an organisation does not have to provide that detail if it does not hold that detail. NHS National Services Scotland cannot provide information on the number of patients as we do not hold this level of detail. We only deliver as far as the Pharmacy Distribution Centre (PDC) in Greater Glasgow & Clyde (GG&C), therefore we do not have records of which hospitals the vials were issued to in that territory. Where a product does not appear, this is because we do not hold any record of vials distributed to NHS Scotland Hospitals for the months requested.

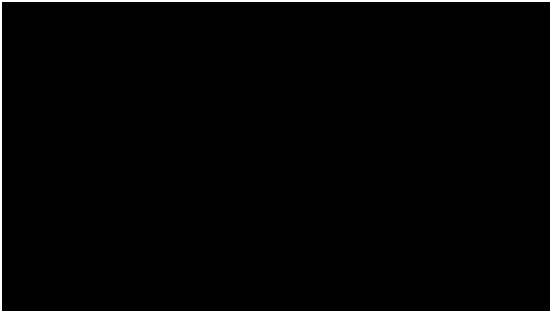
