Please see attached Appendix 1 – Immunoglobin Vials issued to Scottish Hospitals, for the breakdown of immunoglobulin distributed to NHS Scotland Hospitals per month for July, August and September 2024, broken down by product. Under Section 17 of the Freedom of Information Scotland Act, 2002 (FOISA) an organisation does not have to provide that information if it does not hold it. NHS National Services Scotland (NSS) cannot provide information regarding the number of patients by brand as we do not hold this level of detail.
