## PCA(O)2024(05)

PCA(0)2024(05) provides an update on the following:

- General Ophthalmic Services (GOS) remuneration uplifts;
- Community Glaucoma Service (CGS) remuneration uplifts;
- Pre-registration trainee optometrist supervisor grant uplift and claims process;
- Continuing Professional Development (CPD) allowance amounts;
- First port of call responsibility;
- Winter flu and COVID-19 vaccinations.

## **Continuing Professional Development (CPD) allowance**

The CPD form is now hosted on the eOphthalmic system, which will enable you to enter your details directly onto a secure web form and submit them directly to us. This form went live at 07:30 on 30 September 2024 and will be **open until Saturday 30 November 2024**.

If you do not have an eOphthalmic account yet, please visit this page to access all the relevant details and forms to apply for an account. Please note that if access to eOphthalmic is required only for CPD, you will need to state this within the email containing the form.

If you already have an eOphthalmic web form account, you will use the same eOphthalmic log on details to access and submit the new CPD allowance claim form. If your claims are submitted automatically via your Practice Management System (PMS), you must set up a user account for the eOphthalmic system to be able to access and submit the new CPD allowance claim form. In order for you to access and submit the new CPD allowance claim form, we would advise that you complete and submit the relevant application forms now.
